

Stone Mills Arts and Craft Show
JURYING STANDARDS

1. All work displayed for sale must be of the artists or craftsmen's original and handcrafted/executed by the artist/exhibitor. Our goal is to provide a venue for high quality arts and crafts to be displayed and sold.
2. Work should demonstrate skill and mastery of the medium.
3. Traditional crafts should be historically correct and well executed.
4. CRAFT vendors may not display or sell food items in the booth.
5. Dried/silk flowers and materials must be arranged and are not to be sold in bulk.
6. No commercial wearing apparel or T shirts. etc.
7. Ceramics-including the design, firing, and finishing- must be primarily the work of the exhibitor.
8. Candies must be handcrafted and artistically designed.
9. The following are NOT ACCEPTABLE:
 - *Objects made from commercial kits, molds, or patterns
 - *Direct buy/Sell
 - *Imported or manufactured goods
10. JURY decisions will be based on 1) Creativity; 2) Workmanship; 3) Continuity of work; 4) and overall appearance of display. Decisions of the jury are final.

The jury will view only submitted images and application forms. Please do not send additional photographs or resumes. Photos needed with the application are; two pictures of you working on different phases of your art or craft, one of booth setup and several photos of your product.
11. Displays should be set up on Thursday between the hours of 7:00 AM and 8:00PM. On Friday, Saturday and Sunday all vehicles must be off the grounds and parked by the wind mill area by 8:00 AM. The gates for business open 9:00 sharp.
12. Displays may not be taken down until 4:00PM on Sunday , prior to closing. You will not be allowed to leave the show during the three day scheduled event.
13. Please wear your bands that are provided in your registration packets; otherwise you will be charged entrance fees at the gate.
